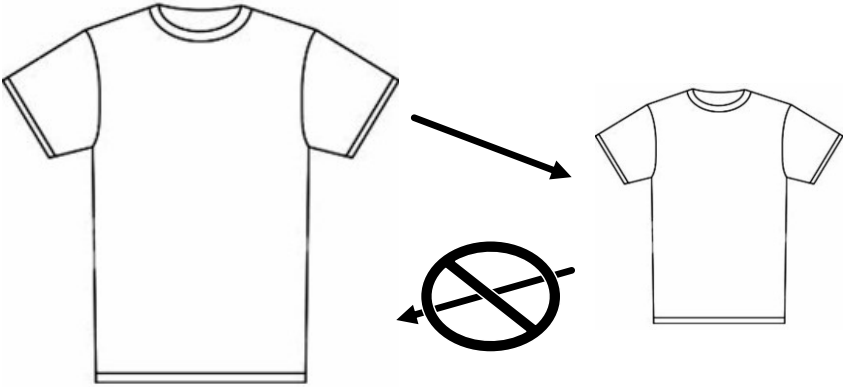


# Before capturing photos

## Recommendations

- ▶ Identifying one member of the team or the group presenting the AOC Project, could be an opportunity
- ▶ Having groups to submit photos of their meetings before they submit their Project, as part of the documentation they have to provide, is an opportunity to have documentation in that stage of the process.
- ▶ If / When possible, do not share photos via WhatsApp, these type of text messaging platforms compress the images to make them easier to be transferred.
  - ▶ When possible try using email or Cloud base storage like Google Drive, etc.

## With and without people in the photos (Use of image consent form)
